 - a. COVID Updates
 - i. Please continue to encourage best practices: self-screening, social distancing, masks ... we don't see school-to-school transmissions as much as what we do from the community.
 - ii. Quarantine update
 1. For students that are contact traced through a school contact
 - All under advisement of the health department
 2. Quarantine reduced to 10 days (return on 11)
 3. May return as early as day 8, with a negative PCR test on day 6 or later
 - Remote Tutoring will be available beginning February for quarantined students. This is being organized through the district.
 - iii. Return to Brick and Mortar/second semester learning options
 1. We added 23 students total.
 2. We are increasing by 30 students to brick and mortar.
 - Hobbs enrollment is just under 700 with students coming back from SRO, Homeschool, or virtual options
 - iv. Air Purifiers in cafeteria and other high traffic areas.
 - Air Purifiers – 4
 - Every classroom and high traffic areas have hand sanitizing stations installed.
