Students, as we practice safety and safety drills every year, it is important to know what they are and why we do them. Over the next several issues of the HMS Times, I will be explaining what each drill is, and why we do them.



First up, the lockdown drill. This protocol is the highest and most

restrictive response to a crisis, threat or emergency on campus. Lockdown occurs when present or imminent danger threatens a site. The protocol should be utilized if a threat on campus is active which can cause significant harm. The lockdown is important because it helps ensure the immediate security of students, staff, and visitors.

When we practice the lockdown drill (we do it at the beginning of every fire drill), it is important that you take these very seriously. The best way to be prepared, is to practice, practice, practice!






Teacher Tea







